STEP 1:

Call the number above to be connected toll-free to the Capitol Switchboard. Ask to speak to one of the senators from your state.

STEP 2:

When the senator's phone is answered, say: "My name is _____ and I live in [your town/city]. As a person of faith, I would like Senator [name] to oppose \$35 billion in cuts to Medicaid, Food Stamps, and other vital services, and to oppose \$70 billion in more tax cuts. Needs of poor families should be a moral priority at this time, not tax cuts for the wealthy."

STEP 3:

Use the toll-free number in step 1 and call your other senator and your representative. If the lines are busy, please be patient and try again. Or, dial their direct lines (not toll-free)—find the numbers at www.senate.gov and www.house.gov
